

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS  
KEY FIELD - MERIDIAN, MISSISSIPPI**

Sealed bids will be received by the Meridian Airport Authority in the airport conference room, Airport Terminal Building, 2811-A Highway 11 South, Meridian, Mississippi until **Monday, August 5, 2019, 2:00 p.m.** Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.

The work is generally described as:

**NEW ACCESS ROAD & FENCING**

Work will involve the removal of existing asphalt and concrete pavement, construction of a new concrete roadway and parking for approximately 0.5 miles of access roads on the airfield and involve installation of approximately 1,500 feet of chain link fence with gates.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond equal to 5% of the total bid is required. Contract security in the form of 100% Performance and Payment Bonds will be required. No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of sixty (60) days. Bidding and Contract Documents may be purchased from the Engineer upon prior payment of a fee of \$50.00, which is non-refundable. Each bidder shall provide a Mississippi Certificate of Responsibility or their bid will not be opened or considered.
