Sealed bids for **Intersection Improvements at U.S. Hwy 45 and Midland Drive** will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Kemper County, Mississippi at the Kemper County Courthouse in DeKalb, Mississippi until **10:30 a.m., Tuesday, March 24, 2020** and shortly thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

Scope of work includes adding a turn lane to the south bound lanes of U.S. Hwy 45 and intersection improvements at the Midland Drive. Items of work include approximately 500 cubic yards of Earthwork, 350 tons of Hot Mixed Asphalt and other items.

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of unit prices and quantities in the contract documents. The work to be done is generally as shown in the plans and technical specifications.
