Sealed bids for **RESTROOM and CONCESSION BUILDING** will be received by the Kemper County Board of Supervisors at the Kemper County Courthouse 280 Veterans Street, DeKalb, Mississippi until **TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 2020 AT 10:00 AM** and shortly thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

Project is for construction of a new 26'x28' concrete block building with concrete slab and asphalt shingle roof. Work includes connection to existing water and sanitary sewer systems, restroom and concession fixtures, electrical components and concrete sidewalks.

### **BASIS OF AWARD:**

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of lump sum price in the contract documents. Actual work performed shall be based on availability of local funds. The work to be done is generally as shown in the plans and in the technical specifications. The Board of Supervisors hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement all minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
