

KEMPER COUNTY BUILDING REQUIREMENTS

When proposing development, individuals should coordinate with utility companies, Mississippi Department of Health and others as appropriate to ensure any development is consistent with State and Federal requirements and that unexpected problems will not occur. Kemper County has no building code or zoning requirements other than an Air Installation Compatible Use Zone (AICUZ) ordinance. The purpose in this ordinance is to ensure that military operations do not cause problems for development.

To expedite processing of AICUZ permits for proposed construction, information must be submitted as follow:
