

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Bids will be publicly read aloud upon receipt. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.

The work is generally described as: **2017 MERIDIAN HIGH SCHOOL PARKING ADDITION – Approximately 5,000 s.y. of concrete surface with curb and gutter.**

Bid Security in the form of a bid bond equal to 5% of the total bid is required. Contract security in the form of 100% Performance Bonds will be required.
