SECTION 900 NOTICE OF ADVERTISEMENT:

Sealed bids will be received for the Board of Supervisors of Jasper County, Mississippi in the Jasper County, Courthouse Building, Bay Springs, MS until 10:00 A.M. on the 19th day of November, 2018 and shortly thereafter opened for the overlay and paving of various county roads under County Project No. 31-18-01. The principal item of work is approximately 1,251 tons of asphaltic hot mix surface course on approximately 1.19 miles of county roads.

BASIS OF AWARD:

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of unit prices and quantities in the contract documents. Actual work quantities performed shall be based on availability of local funds. Work may be added or deleted from the contract to better match funding and needs.

The attention of the BIDDER is directed to the State and Federal laws governing selection of and employment of labor. The Board of Supervisors hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement all minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or natural origin in consideration for an award.

SPECIFICATIONS are on file in the Office of the County Engineer, Meridian, Mississippi. This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest publications of the MISSISSIPPI STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR STATE AID ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION. PLANS AND PROPOSALS may be secured from Terrell W. Temple, County Engineer for Jasper County, Mississippi, 1724B-23rd Ave., Meridian, MS 39301 upon payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) which will not be refunded.

Certified check or bid bond for five (5%) percent of the total bid, made payable to Jasper County must accompany each proposal. Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner the condition under which the proposal is tendered will be considered an irregular bid and such proposal will not be considered in making the award. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids and to waive informalities.
