SECTION 900 NOTICE OF ADVERTISEMENT:

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Lauderdale County, Mississippi on the 11th Floor of the Lauderdale County Courthouse Annex in Meridian, Mississippi until 8:30 A.M. on the 5th day of September, 2017 and shortly thereafter opened for the striping of various county roads under County Project No. 38-17-01. The principal item of work is approximately 15 miles of striping and raised pavement markers on various county roads.

BASIS OF AWARD:

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of unit prices and quantities in the contract documents. Actual work quantities performed shall be based on availability of local funds. Work may be added or deleted from the contract to better match funding and needs.

The attention of the BIDDER is directed to the State and Federal laws governing selection of and employment of labor. The Board of Supervisors hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement all minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or natural origin in consideration for an award.

SPECIFICATIONS are on file in the Office of the County Engineer, Meridian, Mississippi. This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest publications of the MISSISSIPPI STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR STATE AID ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION. PLANS AND PROPOSALS may be secured from Terrell W. Temple, County Engineer for Lauderdale County, Mississippi, 1724B-23rd Ave., Meridian, MS 39301 upon payment of Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00) which will not be refunded.

Certified check or bid bond for five (5%) percent of the total bid, made payable to Lauderdale County must accompany each proposal. Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner the condition under which the proposal is tendered will be considered an irregular bid and such proposal will not be considered in making the award. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids and to waive informalities.
