Sealed bids will be received for the Board of Supervisors of Smith County, Mississippi in the Smith County, Courthouse Annex Building, Raleigh, MS until 9:30 A.M. on the 15th day of August, 2016 and shortly thereafter opened for the repair of damage on County Road 503 under County Project No. 65-16-01. The principal item of work is approximately 1,243 tons of asphaltic hot mix surface course.

BASIS OF AWARD:

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of unit prices and quantities in the contract documents. Actual work quantities performed shall be based on availability of local funds. Work may be added or deleted from the contract to better match funding and needs.

The attention of the BIDDER is directed to the State and Federal laws governing selection of and employment of labor. The Board of Supervisors hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement all minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or natural origin in consideration for an award.

This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest publications of the MISSISSIPPI STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR STATE AID ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION. Temple, County Engineer for Smith County, Mississippi, 1724B-23rd Ave., Meridian, MS 39301 upon payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) which will not be refunded.

Certified check or bid bond for five (5%) percent of the total bid, made payable to Smith County must accompany each proposal. Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner the condition under which the proposal is tendered will be considered an irregular bid and such proposal will not be considered in making the award.
