Sealed bids for Bid No. 3756, Project No. 38-16-03 will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Lauderdale County, Mississippi on the 11<sup>th</sup> Floor of the Lauderdale County Courthouse Annex in Meridian, Mississippi until **8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, the 6th day of September, 2016** and shortly thereafter opened in the Board room on the ground floor.

### **NATURE OF WORK:**

Principal items of work include approximately five miles of Soil Cement and DBST construction. Base repair and leveling for reseal construction and preparation for DBST construction will be by County at no cost to contractor.
