Sealed bids will be received by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Stonewall, Mississippi at City Hall in Stonewall, Mississippi until **10:00 a.m. on Thursday the 25th day of April, 2019** and shortly thereafter opened and read aloud.

WATER TANK REHABILITATION

Principal items of work include rehabilitation of a 665,000 gallon potable water standpipe and a 200,000 gallon elevated potable water tank, consisting of the coating removal of the interior and exterior of both water tanks, replacement of various tank appurtenances, and repainting of the tank interior and exterior including signage.

BASIS OF AWARD:

The award, if made, will be made to the lowest qualified bidder on the basis of unit prices and quantities in the contract documents. Actual work quantities performed shall be based on availability of local funds. The work to be done is generally as shown on the plans. The Mayor and Board of Alderman hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement all minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

SECTION 3 - HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1968:

This project is funded by the HUD Community Development Block Grant Program and is a Section 3 covered activity as defined by the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968 (12 U.S.C. 1701u) (Section 3).
